CALL FOR FIRST ANNUAL (VIRTUAL)

NESO CUP COMPETITION SUBMISSIONS

SUMMARY: NESO will host the First Annual NESO Cup Competition at the Virtual Annual Meeting which will take place Friday, November 6 at 3:30-4:30pm (EST). Each accredited orthodontic program in the NESO region will be permitted to submit a maximum of two entries. Each entry will receive a maximum amount of five minutes to present their TED type presentation. There will be a maximum of 12 TED type presentations presented to the membership on November 6th.

Presentations will be judged by three to four appointed judges. The winning presenter will receive a \$500 prize and an engraved NESO Cup trophy for their display. The second prize winning presenter will receive a \$250 prize. The winner of the competition will be announced at the Annual Business Meeting on Saturday, November 7 (9:00am-10:00am)

SUBMISSION CRITERIA:

1. Submissions must come from the chairperson of accredited orthodontic programs within the NESO region.
2. Each accredited orthodontic program, within the NESO region, may submit a maximum of two entries. Up to one presentation per institution may be awarded.
3. Presenters must be residents of accredited orthodontic programs within the NESO region and NESO members.
4. The topics for discussion may consist of anything from research presentations, case presentations or clinical pearls. Topics are at the full discretion of the presenter(s).
5. Presentations cannot exceed five minutes and will be pre-recorded for presentation at the competition. Presenting Residents must be present at the end of the competition to answer questions live from the review committee members. Presentations that exceed five minutes will be disqualified.
6. All participants must agree to being photographed for future promotional materials.
